

## Chapter 9: Girl Scout Camps

Lakes and Pines offers resident camp at Camp Roundelay and Camp Shingobee Timbers, as well as trips through the Boundary Waters Canoe Wilderness from the Northern Lakes Canoe Base. See the Program Guide, Lakes and Pines web site, and/or any Girl Scout office for details. Camp properties are available for troop use. Outside groups may use properties for a non-member rate. There a variety of equipment for use during your stay.

Sites can be reserved 3 months in advance of arrival date. Complete the Site Reservation form found on the website and in the program guide and return the form along with your payment to the Waite Park office.

### *Camp Austin: 8 miles north of Chisholm, MN*

- On Long Lake.
- Available April 1-December 1.
- Program Center features 3 dormitory style rooms (one room sleeps 16, the other two sleep 12 each), inside restrooms, showers and activity areas, full commercial kitchen with cooking utensils, refrigerator, dishwasher and dishes.
- Outdoor fire ring.
- 10 cabins sleep 4 participants each (starts spring 2010).
- Swimming beach /boating area (no lifeguard provided).
- Primitive tent sites and hiking trails

### *Camp Roundelay: 6 miles east of Wascott, WI*

- Two private lakes.
- Available mid-August-mid-June.
- Waterfront and boating area, miles of hiking trails.
- 16 cabins sleeping from 6 to 12 each and 2 covered wagons that sleep 6 each.
- Outdoor shower house and amphitheatre.
- Primitive tent sites.
- Full use program center that sleeps 36 (NOTE: no cots or beds). Winterized for year round use.
- Full sized kitchen: kettles, dishes and silverware.
- American Camp Association (ACA) accredited

### *Camp Shingobee Timbers: 5 miles south of Walker, MN*

- On Big Bass Lake.
- Available mid-August to mid-June.
- Winterized program center features two wings, each sleeps 20 and an apartment which sleeps 3. Each wing has bedrooms, bathroom and shower, kitchenette with sink, stove, refrigerator, kettles, dishes, and silverware, and a fireplace. Apartment features: kitchen, bedroom, living room with fireplace, and bathroom with tub.
- Seven tent cabins sleep 6-8 people each.
- Primitive tent sites for up to 15 people each.
- Swimming beach and boating area (no lifeguard provided).

### *Janette Pollay Program Center: Duluth, MN*

- Sleeps 36 with small kitchen , running water.
- Available year round.
- No indoor plumbing restrooms or shower facility.
- Limited tenting available / hiking trails.
- Outside pavilion and fire place.
- ACA accredited

### *Northern Lakes Canoe Base: 13 miles east of Ely, MN*

- Primitive camping at the edge of the Boundary Waters.
- Not available for rental as there are no winterized facilities. Fully programmed in the summer with wilderness canoe trips for girls from our council and around the world.
